The Clinical Quality Lead is responsible for establishing consistent, high-quality, evidence-based models of care across all sites that are consistent with the mission, vision and values of the organization, all relevant federal and provincial regulations, and other pertinent standards. They will work within a LEADS framework to achieve and sustain excellence in patient safety and quality, and leading program development with evidence. They will collaborate regularly with the clinical leadership team to design, implement, and evaluate care delivery models for our residents and patients, set practice standards, facilitate definition of care processes and procedures, facilitate design of education and training, and contribute to clinical quality/risk management strategy development.

General Accountabilities

- Monitor federal, provincial, and other relevant legislation/regulations for compliance and collaborate on strategies to address opportunities for improvement.
- Provide expert knowledge and professional practice leadership to develop solutions/service delivery models for exceptional care, in collaboration with the clinical leadership team and the interdisciplinary team.
- Collaborate with clinical leadership to ensure the implementation, sustainability, and evaluation of exemplary clinical practices.
- Encourage and model critical clinical inquiry that cultivates evidence-informed practice.
- Identify opportunities to lead and/or support development of proposals for funding or research opportunities, as required.
- Support clinical practice leaders and the clinical leadership team through regular meetings, mentorship, consultation and guidance with complex clinical situations.
- Acts as an expert resource to department managers, physicians, and other members of the health care team regarding process improvement initiatives, data collection, and interpretation.
- Establish contracts for organization-wide services (e.g. Pharmacy Services) and consult, as needed, with the individual sites to support their efforts to establish site-specific services (e.g. vision, dental care).
