Rehabilitation Assistant - Internationally educated Occupational Therapist

Our team of Rehabilitation Assistants works under the supervision of the Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists to deliver group and individual therapies in our slow-paced rehabilitative care program. They focus on the patients' functional abilities, mobility and motivation to deliver treatments and skill development activities that increase strength, range of motion, balance and endurance. They help patients to adapt to the use of mobility aids and manage activities of daily living. The Rehabilitation Assistants participate as members of the interprofessional team in delivering patient services.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- You have a Bachelor of Science degree or Master of Science degree in Occupational Therapy. Your education must have either been completed in Ontario or have been deemed equivalent by the College Registration Committee. Education outside of Canada is reviewed by ACOTRO.
- You have graduated from an approved occupational therapy program within the past 18 months, completed 600 hours of occupational therapy practice within the last 3 years, or successfully completed a college-approved refresher program within the last 18 months.
- You have met the education and clinical practicum requirement by completing the Substantial Equivalency Assessment System (SEAS) and received a disposition report that indicates that your education and competencies are substantially equivalent to a Canadian-educated occupational therapist.
- 1-2 years of experience in a hospital setting
- Experience in geriatrics and slow-paced rehabilitation preferred.
- COVID Vaccination (2 Doses) is required to work in our facility.
